
#### **AfriNIC-2 Meeting**

- Maputo 26 and 27 April 2005
  - ~80 attendees composed of people from all around Africa region and representatives of RIRs, ICANN and the ASO AC/NRO NC
  - Election of the First ASO AC/NRO NC representatives from AfriNIC region.
    - Jean Robert Hountomey
    - Sonia Geea
    - Alan Barrett
  - Renewal of two seats on the board
  - Discussion of new policy proposals
  - Adoption of Fee schedule + Budget for 2005

## **AfriNIC training**

One of our challenge is awareness of ISP in our region on IP resource management.

- Develop a bilingual training plan which will allow us to run up to 10 trainings per year (an average of one a month).
- 7 very successful trainings have already been organized during the past 6 months:
  - ~90 participants from more than 15 countries
  - French and English
- Next training will happen next week in Libreville followed by two other in Pretoria and in Cairo.





#### Participation to the International Technical coordination fora

- Full participation into the ASO-AC by elected representatives
- AfriNIC has Joined the NRO as full member and participate into all its activities (EC, ECG, CCG):
- More active participation into the WSIS discussions and African position on Internet governance issues.
- Working with NREN to support some IP related work done by universities in Africa.
- To launch v6Mandela Network: A project to educate our community on IPv6 and ease experience sharing around the continent – First meeting to be held in Cairo on the 12/12/05



#### **Policies under discussion**

- Temporary Assignments & assignments for critical establishments (like IXPs)
- Direct/PI Assignments from AfriNIC to end-user organisations
- Criteria for AS numbers assignment.
- Global policy for IPv6 Allocation from IANA to RIRs.
  - Status: Currently under discussion on the mailing lists (policy-wg@afrinic.net)
  - Will be presented again at AfriNIC-3 for consensus from the community.



  - Working on deployment of WHOIS mirrors in Cairo and Cape Town




## Membership growth 2005






#### 2005 vs 2004
