Consumer Broadband Monitoring

- Presentation at RIPE50 by Niall O'Reilly
 - Monitoring between ISP and end users
 - Discussion in the working group

Summary

- Install a device at end-user homes
 - Cheap, easy to deploy, no maintenance
 - Measure between end-user and TB at ISP, then to TBs at other ISPs
- First step:
 - Proof of concept
 - Get an overview of all issues related to offering this as a service
 - Few months of work
- Decision point on how to proceed

How to proceed?

- PDP
 - Discussion of the idea

 - Detailed proposal
 - Review, last-call (2 months)
- Start work 1/1/2006
- Review of results at RIPE52
 - Is this what we want?
